

General Camp Information

For everyone attending camp

What to Bring:

Bedding(Sheets for twin size bunk, blanket, pillow)

Towels

Toiletries

Sun Screen

Bible

Pen or Pencil

Clothing- Casual clothing is appropriate during all activities at camp, with the understanding that all clothing should reflect Christian modesty and discretion. Shorts **must** be at least fingertip length when Arms are straight down at sides, No sheer clothing, No low cut dress necklines or deep armholes in girls dresses or shirts, No deep cut armholes or necklines in guys tank style shirts. No spaghetti string straps on shirts or dresses, **No two piece bathing suits** ALL bathing suits must be covered when not at the pool. Wind shorts need to have a moderate slit.

Rec Clothes (Recreation may be messy. Bring clothes you don't mind getting soiled)

Extra Spending Money- **During High School and Middle School only** there will be a Camp Concession Stand during free time. Campers may purchase soft drinks and candy during this time.

Medication- If you bring prescription or over the counter medications we will ask you to complete a medication information/administration release form. This alerts us to any potential health problems and lets us know how to help you.

What Not to Bring:

Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, (in any form) firearms, knives or other kinds of weapons, electronics, iPods, iPads, MP3 players, televisions, any type of electronic games or equipment, pagers, cellular phones, or computers.
